The **Incraftables Acrylic Paint Pens** set includes 12 assorted vibrant colors with a 5mm tip capable of producing a 2mm line thickness. These pens are designed

for use on multiple surfaces such as paper, canvas, wood, metal, glass, and ceramics. The water-based acrylic ink offers quick-drying, opaque coverage, perfect for DIY projects, crafts, and personalized art.



WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- 12 Acrylic Paint Pens (assorted colors)
- Each pen has a 5mm tip with 2mm line thickness

TOOLS NEEDED:

- A clean surface for painting (canvas, paper, wood, metal, etc.)
- Scrap paper or a testing surface
- A damp cloth or paper towel (for cleaning up mistakes)



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Prepare Your Workspace

Ensure the surface you're working on is clean, dry, and ready to be painted. For smooth surfaces like glass or metal, wipe them down with a clean cloth to remove dust or oils.

2. Shake the Paint Pen

 Vigorously shake each paint pen for 10-20 seconds before use. This helps mix the acrylic paint for an even, vibrant flow of ink.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

3. Prime the Tip

- · Remove the cap.
- Press the tip down on a scrap piece of paper or your testing surface until you see paint flowing through the tip.



You may need to press a few times to get the ink flowing consistently.



4. Start Painting

 Use the paint pen on your chosen surface, applying even pressure for control.
Use the tip for fine lines and the side for broader strokes. Switch colors easily by capping one pen and priming another.



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



5. Layer Colors (Optional)

To layer or blend colors, allow the first layer to dry completely before applying another layer of paint. This prevents smudging and ensures clean lines.

6. Allow Time to Dry

 The paint will dry relatively quickly, but allow extra time for thick applications or layered areas. Typically, the paint will be dry to the touch within 10-30 minutes, depending on surface and paint thickness.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



7. Clean Up

 Use a damp cloth to wipe away any mistakes on nonporous surfaces before the paint dries. For porous surfaces, the paint will be permanent once dried.

8. Store the Pens

 After use, ensure the caps are securely placed back on the pens to prevent the paint from drying out.
Store pens horizontally in a cool, dry place for optimal ink flow.





TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Test each color on scrap paper before applying to your project to ensure smooth ink flow.
- For intricate detailing, use light pressure and focus on the tip of the pen.
- Clean the tips occasionally by wiping with a damp cloth if they become clogged or dry.
