WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- 80 charms (20 styles)
- 15 clasps
- 15 jump rings

TOOLS NEEDED:

- **Round-Nose Pliers:** For opening and closing jump rings without bending or scratching them.
- **Flat-Nose Pliers:** To securely grip and twist rings when attaching clasps and charms.
- **Wire Cutters (optional):** Useful for trimming any extra links or cutting wire if you're adding other materials to your project.



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Gather Your Supplies

- Open the kit and lay out your charms, clasps, and jump rings for easy access.

2. Choose Your Charms

- Select the butterfly charms you want to use for your project.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

3. Prepare the Jump Rings

- Take a jump ring and use pliers to gently twist it open, creating a gap.



4. Attach the Charm

- Slide the charm onto the open jump ring, then also thread on the clasp if you're making jewelry.



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

5. Close the Jump Ring

- Use pliers to twist the jump ring back together securely.



6. Repeat as Desired

- Continue adding charms and clasps until you achieve your desired look!

PRO TIPS:

- Make sure to close each jump ring tightly to keep your charms secure and looking great!
