

# CANDLE MAKING KIT/ wahuay





Welcome to the Incraftables Candle Making Starter Kit! This kit includes everything you need to create beautiful, fragrant candles at home. Follow this manual step-by-step to ensure the best results and enjoy the process of crafting your candles.

# safety instructions

- Always work on a flat, stable surface.
- Use protective gear such as gloves and safety glasses.
- Keep children and pets away from your workspace.
- Never leave melted wax unattended.
- Be cautious with hot wax and surfaces to avoid burns.

• Soy Wax: 300g

Essential Oils: 2 bottlesJars with Lids: 2 setsCotton Wicks: 20 pcs

Stirring Sticks: 2 pcsDried Flowers: 2 bags

Gift Packing: 3 pcs

# preparation

Before starting, gather all materials and set up your workspace. Ensure you have access to a heat source (like a stove) and a thermometer (optional but recommended).

# step-by-step instructions

#### STEP 1 PREPARE YOUR WORK AREA

- Cover your work surface with newspaper or a protective cloth.
- 2. Lay out all your materials within easy reach.
- 3. Have a pot or double boiler ready for melting the wax.







#### STEP 2 MELTING THE SOY WAX

- 1. Measure the desired amount of soy wax (150g per candle).
- 2. Place the soy wax into the candle making pot.
- Heat the pot on low to medium heat, stirring occasionally with a stirring stick.
- 4. Monitor the temperature (ideal melting temperature for soy wax is around 170°F or 77°C)





#### STEP 3 ADDING ESSENTIAL OILS AND DRIED FLOWERS

- 1. Once the wax is melted, remove it from heat.
- Add 10-15 drops of essential oil per 150g of wax, depending on the desired fragrance strength.
- 3. Stir gently to combine.
- 4. Optionally, add a small amount of dried flowers to the mixture.



#### STEP 4 SETTING UP THE WICK

- 1. Place a cotton wick in the center of each jar.
- Use a drop of melted wax to secure the metal base of the wick to the bottom of the jar.
- Ensure the wick is straight and centered (you can use a wick holder or a pencil to hold it in place).



#### STEP 5 POURING THE WAX

- Carefully pour the melted wax into the jars, avoiding splashes.
- 2. Leave a small gap at the top of each jar (about 1/2 inch).





#### STEP 6 COOLING AND SETTING

- Allow the candles to cool and set undisturbed for several hours (preferably overnight).
- 2. Check occasionally to ensure the wick stays centered.



#### STEP 7 TRIMMING THE WICK

- Once the candles are fully set, trim the wick to about 1/4 inch above the wax surface.
- 2. Place the lids on the jars if desired.



### decorating and packaging

- · Use the gift packing provided to decorate your candles.
- Add personal touches such as labels or ribbons to make your candles unique gifts.

# cleaning and storage

- Clean the candle making pot and stirring sticks with warm, soapy water.
- Store remaining materials in a cool, dry place for future use.

## troubleshooting

- Uneven Surface: If the surface of your candle is uneven, you
  can use a heat gun or hair dryer to melt the top layer and
  allow it to reset.
- Sinking Wick: Ensure the wick is secured properly at the bottom before pouring the wax.

# tips and tricks

- Experiment with different essential oil combinations to create custom scents.
- Use a thermometer to ensure optimal melting temperatures and avoid overheating the wax.
- For a more decorative look, arrange dried flowers at the bottom of the jar before pouring the wax.
