PRODUCT INSTRUCTIONS



The **Incraftables Embroidery String Kit** is a comprehensive set designed for embroidery enthusiasts of all levels, providing everything needed to begin or enhance embroidery projects. With 100 colorful embroidery threads, this kit offers an excellent variety for creating intricate designs, patterns, and details in various needlework projects.



WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- **Embroidery String Thread:** 100 vibrant skeins in a variety of colors
- **Embroidery Needles:** 10 pieces
- **Threaders:** 2 pieces to assist with threading needles
- **Floss Bobbins:** 12 pieces for organizing and managing threads

TOOLS NEEDED:

This kit is nearly complete for beginners and hobbyists, but a few additional items are recommended to make your projects easier:

- **Embroidery Hoop** (if desired, to keep fabric taut)
- **Scissors** for trimming threads
- **Fabric** for embroidery



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Set Up

- Organize your threads with the floss bobbins for easy access and to prevent tangling.
- Choose a fabric and, if needed, secure it in an embroidery hoop.

2. Threading the Needle

- Use the threaders provided to make threading the embroidery needles easier, especially with finer threads.
- Select the desired color and pull a suitable length to work with.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

3. Start Embroidering

- Knot the end of the thread, and begin stitching as per your design.
- You can use various stitches like backstitch, satin stitch, or French knots depending on your design.



4. Finishing Up

- Once your design is complete, trim excess thread and secure the back of your embroidery with a knot or by weaving the ends under nearby stitches.



TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- **Thread Management:** Use the bobbins to wrap unused thread and label colors if needed for easy reference.
- **Preventing Knots:** Avoid cutting very long threads to reduce tangling while you work.
- **Practice Stitches:** Try out different stitches on a scrap piece of fabric to perfect your technique before starting on your main project.
- **Color Blending:** Experiment with blending two colors for unique shading effects in your designs.
