PRODUCT INSTRUCTIONS



The **Incraftables Evil Eye Beads Kit** is a vibrant jewelry-making set for all ages. It includes 720 evil eye beads in 24 colors, elastic string, clasps, jump rings, and an organizer box. Perfect for crafting bracelets, necklaces, and earrings, the protective evil eye design adds a stylish, meaningful touch.



WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- **720 pcs Round Evil Eye Beads** (24 colors, 30 pieces per color)
- **15 pcs clasps**
- **15 pcs jump rings**
- **Elastic thread**
- **Organizer box** for easy storage and organization

TOOLS NEEDED:

- Beading needle (any size will work)
- Scissors or jewelry cutting tool
- Pliers (optional, for working with clasps and jump rings)



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Organize the Beads

- Sort the beads by color in the organizer box to easily plan your design. Lay out your pattern before starting.

2. Measure the Elastic String

- For bracelets, wrap the string around your wrist, adding 2-3 extra inches for knots. For necklaces or anklets, measure the desired length plus extra for securing.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

3. String the Beads

- Thread the beads onto the elastic in your chosen pattern. Avoid overstretching the string as you go.



4. Secure the Jewelry

- Once the beads are strung, tie a double or triple knot at the ends. For added security, apply glue to the knot. Optionally, attach clasps with jump rings for a polished finish.



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



5. Attach Clasps

- Thread the elastic through a jump ring, tie a knot, and use pliers to attach the clasp securely.

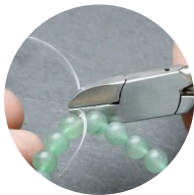
6. Explore Additional Ideas

- Use the beads to make earrings, keychains, or friendship bracelets by attaching them to hooks or key rings with jump rings.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



7. **Finishing and Storage**

- Trim excess string and store leftover beads and supplies in the organizer for future projects.

TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Avoid overstretching the elastic.
- Secure knots tightly.
- Experiment with different color combinations.
- Ensure jump rings are fully closed with pliers for durability.

Bracelets & Anklets:

- Evil eye beads make great focal points for wrap bracelets or anklets. Use multiple colors to create vibrant, protective pieces.



Necklaces:

Earrings:

- Create lightweight, colorful earrings using the evil eye beads and earring hooks for a fun accessory.

Keychains & Charms:

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

- To maintain the quality of your jewelry, avoid exposing it to water or chemicals, as these can weaken the elastic string or damage the beads.
- Store your finished jewelry pieces in a dry place to prevent the elastic from losing its elasticity over time.
