1. Preparation

2. Cutting

 Use scissors or a cutting machine to cut the faux leather into your desired shapes and sizes. If using a cutting machine, follow the manufacturer's settings for faux leather materials.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

3. Marking and Measuring

 Use a ruler and pen/chalk to mark any measurements or patterns on the back side of the faux leather sheets.





4. Adhering

 Apply a strong adhesive to attach the faux leather pieces to your project.
 Press firmly to ensure a good bond. Allow the glue to dry completely before handling.

5. Finishing Touches

 If your project involves sewing, you can stitch the pieces together using a sewing machine or by hand. If adding hardware like keychains, use a hole punch to create the necessary holes.

6. Cleanup

 Store any leftover faux leather sheets in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to maintain their quality.





TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Test Cuts: Always perform a test cut with your cutting machine on a small piece of faux leather to ensure you have the correct settings.
- Sharp Tools: Use sharp scissors or blades to achieve clean and precise cuts.
