PRODUCT INSTRUCTIONS



The **Incraftables Sponge Foam Brush Set** includes 24 sponge foam brushes in four different sizes, designed for a variety of craft, DIY, and painting projects. The foam brushes are ideal for smooth application of paint, varnish, stain, and more, making them versatile tools for both beginner and experienced crafters.



WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- **Total Sponge Foam Brushes: 24 pieces**
 - 1-inch brushes: 13 pieces
 - 2-inch brushes: 7 pieces
 - 3-inch brushes: 2 pieces
 - 4-inch brushes: 2 pieces

TOOLS NEEDED:

- **Paint or stain** (depending on your project)
- **Protective gloves** (optional, to keep hands clean)
- **Paint tray or cup** (for dipping)



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Prep the Surface

- Ensure the surface you're painting is clean and dry. If necessary, sand rough areas and remove dust.



2. Dip the Brush

- Lightly dip the foam brush into your paint or stain. Avoid oversaturating, as too much liquid can cause drips or uneven application.

3. Apply Paint

- Use smooth, even strokes to apply paint to the surface. For best results, use the appropriate size brush for the area:
 - 1-inch: Small details and edges.
 - 2-inch: Medium-sized areas and smooth strokes.
 - 3-inch & 4-inch: Larger surfaces for broader coverage.



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

4. Rinse After Use

- Rinse and squeeze out excess paint if you plan to reuse the brushes.



TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Use a light hand with foam brushes for even application and to avoid streaks.
- For a softer finish, use a dabbing or stippling technique.
- After cleaning, store brushes in a cool, dry place to maintain shape and foam integrity.
