



The Incraftables Indian Agate Beads set includes 20 high-quality, natural Indian Agate beads, each measuring 12mm in diameter.

These beads are ideal for various jewelry-making and crafting projects, whether for bracelets, necklaces, earrings, or mixed media designs. Each bead has a 6mm hole, making them versatile for a range of stringing materials.



WHAT'S INCLUDED:

 20 Indian Agate Beads (12mm in size, with 6mm hole size)

TOOLS NEEDED:

- Jewelry-making wire, cord, or elastic that is 6mm or smaller in diameter to fit the bead holes
- Jewelry pliers or cutters, depending on the stringing material used
- Beading mat or tray to keep beads in place
- Optional: Jewelry glue (for securing knots)



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Design Your Layout

 Decide on the pattern and layout for your beads, especially if you're combining them with other beads.

2. Stringing the Beads

 Select your preferred stringing material. Ensure it's no thicker than 6mm to pass through each bead hole easily.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

3. Securing the Ends

 Once all beads are on the string, tie a knot, or secure with a clasp if making a necklace or bracelet.
 Apply a dab of jewelry glue on the knot for added durability if using elastic.





4. Finishing Touches

 Trim any excess stringing material to finish your piece neatly.



TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Plan Your Design: Lay out your design on a bead board or mat to visualize your pattern before stringing.
- Use a Needle: For thin cord materials, consider using a beading needle for easier threading.
- Sturdy Material: For heavier pieces, like necklaces, consider using a wire or sturdy cord to hold the weight of the 12mm beads securely.
- Knot Between Beads: If you're making a bracelet or necklace, knotting between each bead can add durability and style.
