# lobster clasps

PRODUCT INSTRUCTIONS





The **Incraftables Lobster Clasps** are essential components for jewelry making, crafting, and other DIY projects. This set includes 132 pieces of 12mm lobster clasps and 132 pieces of 5mm open jump rings, providing a complete kit for securing chains, bracelets, and necklaces.



## WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- **Lobster Clasps:** 132 pieces (12mm size)
- **Open Jump Rings:** 132 pieces (5mm size)

## TOOLS NEEDED:

- **Round Nose Pliers:** For creating loops and opening jump rings.
- **Chain Nose Pliers:** For gripping and bending wire.
- **Wire Cutters:** To trim excess wire or chain.
- **Beading Mat:** To keep your workspace organized and prevent beads from rolling away.



## STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



### 1. Prepare Your Materials

- Gather all components you plan to use, including beads, chains, and the lobster clasps.

### 2. Open the Jump Ring

- Use the round nose pliers to hold one end of the jump ring.
- Gently twist the other side of the jump ring open, avoiding any bending that might weaken the ring.





## STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

### 3. Attach the Lobster Clasp

- Slide the lobster clasp onto the open jump ring.
- If needed, add other components (like chains or beads) to the jump ring at this time.



### 4. Close the Jump Ring

- Use the pliers to carefully twist the jump ring back into its original shape, ensuring it is fully closed to secure the clasp.



## STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

### 5. Repeat as Needed

- Continue this process for each lobster clasp you want to attach.



## TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- **Test the Closure:** Before using your jewelry, make sure the lobster clasp opens and closes smoothly.
- **Avoid Overloading:** Do not overload the jump rings with too many components, as this can cause the jump ring to weaken or break.
- **Practice with Spare Materials:** If you're new to jewelry making, practice with spare components until you feel comfortable working with the clasps and jump rings.
- **Keep Your Workspace Organized:** Use a small container or a beading tray to keep track of your clasps and rings while working.
