## WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- **Resin Supplies Kit Total Count:** 93 pieces
- **Epoxy Resin Bottles:** 2 pieces
- **Dried Flowers:** 12 pieces
- **Colored Mica Powders:** 12 pieces
- **Earring Hooks:** 20 pieces (available in Silver and Gold)

- **Necklace Chains:** 4 pieces
- **Keychain Rings:** 4 pieces

## TOOLS NEEDED:

- **Protective gear:** Gloves and a mask
- **Work surface:** Drop cloth or disposable covering
- **Scissors:** For cutting gold foil sheets and adjusting chains
- **Heat gun or torch (optional):** For removing bubbles from resin
- **Paper towels:** For clean-up and excess resin removal



## STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



### 1. Prepare

- Set up a protected workspace. Wear finger cots to keep hands clean.

### 2. Mix Resin

- Combine equal parts from both resin bottles in a measuring cup, stirring with a wooden stick.





## STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

### 3. Add Color/Decor

- Mix in mica powder for color. Use tweezers to place dried flowers or gold foil in the mold.



### 4. Pour & Cure

- Pour resin into the mold. Allow it to cure undisturbed for 24-48 hours.



## STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

### 5. Finish

- Demold carefully. Attach earring hooks, necklace chains, or keychain rings to your pieces.



## TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- **Bubble Reduction:** Warm the resin slightly or stir slowly to minimize bubbles.
- **Layering:** For designs with more depth, pour resin in layers, allowing each layer to partially cure before adding the next.
- **Cleaning Molds:** Clean molds with mild soap and water, ensuring they're completely dry before storing.
