TOOLS NEEDED:

- · Wire cutters (for cutting wire and string)
- Needle-nose pliers (for bending wire and opening/closing jump rings)
- Scissors (for cutting elastic string)
- Ruler or measuring tape (for measuring string length)
- Beading mat or tray (optional, for keeping beads organized while working)



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Design Your Jewelry

 Plan the design of your piece by laying out the beads in the desired pattern.

2. Cut the String or Wire

 Measure and cut an appropriate length of elastic string or silver wire. For bracelets, aim for about 7-8 inches, plus extra for tying knots.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

3. String the Beads

- For elastic string: Simply thread the beads onto the string, ensuring you leave enough length at both ends for tying.
- For silver wire: Use the needlenose pliers to create loops on either end of your wire for attaching clasps and jump rings.





4. Secure the Ends

- For elastic string: Tie a double knot to secure the beads, trimming any excess string.
- For silver wire: Attach clasps and jump rings using pliers to ensure a secure closure.



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

5. Final Touches

 Check your jewelry piece for any loose beads or knots, and make adjustments as needed.



TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Bead Arrangement: Experiment with color combinations and sizes to create unique designs.
- Pre-stretch Elastic String: Gently stretch the elastic string before use to reduce the risk of your finished piece sagging over time.
- Use a Beading Mat: This will help keep your beads from rolling away and make it easier to see your design.
- Secure Knots: If using elastic, consider adding a drop of jewelry glue on the knots for extra security.
- Practice with Wire: If you're new to using wire, practice bending and cutting it before starting your project to gain confidence.
- Store Properly: After use, keep your beads organized in the provided box to prevent loss and tangling.
