Incraftables Sewing Clips are an essential tool for crafters, quilters, and seamstresses. These clips provide a convenient and effective way to hold multiple layers of fabric together without damaging them, unlike traditional pins. With a colorful variety and a sturdy design, they are perfect for both professional and hobbyist sewing projects.



WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- **Sewing Clips:** 100 pieces in total
- **Color Variety:** 9 different colors for easy organization and aesthetic appeal
 - **Size:** Each clip measures approximately 1.06 inches (L) x 0.16 inches (W) x 0.35 inches (H)

TOOLS NEEDED:

- **Sewing Machine:** For sewing your fabric pieces together.
- **Fabric:** The materials you wish to sew.
- **Cutting Mat and Rotary Cutter (optional):** For precise cutting of fabric.
- **Ruler and Fabric Marker (optional):** For marking fabric before cutting or sewing.



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Preparation

- Gather your fabric pieces and any additional tools.
- Lay out your fabric pieces as desired for your project.

2. Clipping Fabric

- Open the clip and position it over the edge of the fabric layers you wish to hold together.
- Close the clip securely to hold the fabric in place.
- Repeat the process, spacing the clips evenly along the seam.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

3. Sewing

- Once all fabric pieces are clipped, proceed to sew as per your project instructions.
- As you sew, remove the clips as you reach them to avoid any interference with the sewing machine.



4. Final Touches

- After sewing, ensure all clips have been removed and check your seams for evenness.



TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- **Use Different Colors:** Utilize the variety of clip colors to differentiate between fabric layers or types (e.g., right sides versus wrong sides).
- **Don't Overclip:** While it's tempting to use many clips, aim for a spacing of about 3-4 inches apart to maintain fabric integrity.
- **Seam Allowances:** Ensure that your clips are positioned within the seam allowance to avoid them being caught in the stitches.
- **Clip Orientation:** Clip from the bottom side of the fabric to keep the clips out of the sewing path when you're sewing.
- **Storage:** Keep your clips organized in a small container or bag to prevent loss and ensure easy access.
