STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Set Up

 Select a spool of thread in your desired color. Each spool contains 120 yards, perfect for both hand sewing and machine sewing projects.

2. Threading the Needle

- Choose one of the provided needles.
- Use a needle threader if needed. Insert the wire loop of the threader through the needle's eye, place the thread through the loop, and pull it back through the needle.






STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

3. Securing Your Stitch

- Tie a small knot at the end of the thread to secure your stitch.
- For hand sewing, doublethreading the needle (folding the thread in half) provides extra strength for seams.





4. Sewing Techniques

- Running Stitch: A basic stitch, ideal for simple seams or basting.
- Backstitch: Provides a sturdy hold, great for seams under stress.
- Whip Stitch: Best for hemming or finishing edges.



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

5. Finishing the Thread

 Once your stitch is complete, secure the end with a few small backstitches and trim the excess.



TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Selecting Thread Color: Match the thread color to your fabric for an invisible look, or pick contrasting colors for decorative stitching.
- Avoiding Tangles: Run the thread through beeswax or conditioner to reduce tangling.



TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Thread Length: Keep the thread under 18 inches for hand sewing to prevent knotting.
- Needle Maintenance: Swap needles if they become dull, as a sharper needle will give you cleaner stitches and avoid snagging.
- Organizing Spools: Use a thread organizer to keep the spools neat and avoid unraveling, preserving thread quality.
