TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Design Planning: Lay out your charms and beads beforehand to visualize the final look. Consider spacing charms evenly if using multiple.
- Mixed Materials: Combine charms with other materials, like silicone beads or gemstone beads, to create dynamic designs.
- Use Quality Tools: Jewelry pliers with a smooth grip (not serrated) prevent scratching the metal finish on your charms.
- Layering: Create layered bracelets or necklaces by mixing and matching word charms, offering a variety of messages or themes.
- Charm Care: To maintain the charm's silver finish, avoid exposing it to water or chemicals and store it in a dry place.
