### **TOOLS NEEDED:**

- Craft Knife or Scissors: For cutting or shaping foam balls if needed.
- Glue: A strong adhesive like hot glue or craft glue for attaching pieces together.
- Paint: Acrylic or craft paint for coloring the foam balls.
- Paintbrushes: For applying paint and embellishments.
- Markers or Pens: For adding designs or details.
- Embellishments: Items like glitter, sequins, or fabric for decorating.



### PROJECT IDEAS:

- Ornamental Decorations: Create hanging ornaments for holidays or special events. Use paint, glitter, sequins, or small beads to decorate each foam ball.

# STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



#### 1. Painting the Foam Balls

- Use acrylic or tempera paint for smooth, even coverage.
- For a long-lasting finish, apply a layer of clear sealant after the paint dries.

#### 2. Glittering

- Apply a thin layer of craft glue over the surface.
- Sprinkle glitter over the ball, shaking off any excess.
  For a stronger hold, mix the glitter with the glue before applying.





# STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

## 3. Attaching Multiple Balls Together

- To secure multiple balls, use a strong glue like hot glue or craft glue.
- For added stability in sculptural pieces, insert a toothpick or skewer between the balls before gluing.





## 4. Decorating with Sequins and Beads

- Use small straight pins to attach sequins, beads, or other small embellishments.
- For a quicker application, apply dots of glue and press the sequins or beads into place.



# TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Priming for Smooth Painting: Apply a thin layer of gesso on the foam balls before painting to create a smoother surface.
- Stabilizing for Detail Work: Place each foam ball on a wooden skewer or toothpick to hold it steady while painting or decorating.
- Preventing Glue Damage: Avoid using hightemperature glue guns, which may melt the foam; lowtemperature hot glue is safer.
- Uniform Coverage: When adding glitter, roll the ball in glitter rather than sprinkling for more even coverage.
- Creative Bases: Foam balls can serve as a base for paper mache, clay, or other materials for layered projects.
