### WHAT'S INCLUDED:

 3 Soap Molds: Each mold features a unique shape and pattern for variety in your soapmaking projects.

#### **TOOLS NEEDED:**

- Soap base (glycerin, shea butter, or goat milk)
- · Essential oils or fragrance (optional)
- · Colorants (optional)
- · Mixing bowl and spatula
- Microwave-safe container (for melting)
- Alcohol spray (to reduce bubbles)



### STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



#### 1. Prepare Soap Base

 Cut the soap base into small chunks for easy melting.

#### 2. Melt Soap Base

 Place the chunks in a microwave-safe container. Heat in intervals of 20-30 seconds, stirring between intervals, until completely melted.





# STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

#### 3. Add Fragrance and Color

 If desired, add essential oils and colorants. Stir well for even distribution.





#### 4. Pour into Molds

 Carefully pour the melted soap base into each mold, filling it to the top.



# STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

#### 5. Reduce Bubbles

 Spray a light mist of alcohol on the surface to eliminate any bubbles.





### 6. Let Set and Remove from Molds

- Allow the soap to cool and harden, typically for 2-3 hours.
- Gently press the back of each mold to release the soap without damage.



# TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Layering Technique: Pour one layer, let it harden slightly, and pour another to create multi-colored or multi-textured bars.
- Use Dried Flowers or Herbs: Place these items in the mold before pouring in the soap for a beautiful, natural look.
- Cleanup: Silicone molds are easy to clean; simply rinse with warm water and mild soap after use. Avoid using harsh scrubbing tools that could damage the molds
