STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Select Placement Area

- Choose the spot on your material (such as leather, denim, or fabric) where you'd like to attach the spike or stud.
- Use a washable marker or chalk to mark placement for precise alignment, especially when working with multiple studs or creating patterns.

2. Prepare the Hole (if needed)

- Use the Punch Tool to create a small hole in the fabric or material. Place the tool over your marked spot, press down, and rotate gently to pierce the fabric. This step helps ensure a smooth insertion and secure hold.
- Adjust the size of the hole based on the stud or spike size.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

3. Attach the Spike or Stud

- Insert the spike or stud into the hole. Ensure it sits flat against the surface.
- Using the Screwdriver, secure the back screw or attachment piece onto the spike or stud to hold it in place. Tighten until it is firmly attached but avoid overtightening to prevent damage.





4. Repeat for Additional Studs/Spikes

 Repeat these steps for each spike or stud, following your marked pattern or desired design.



TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Choose the Right Size: Use smaller spikes for tighter spaces or delicate designs and larger spikes for bold, statement pieces.
- Pattern Planning: Before attaching, lay out spikes on your material to visualize your design.
- Reinforcement for Thin Fabrics: For thinner fabrics, add an adhesive fabric patch behind the attachment area for extra strength and durability.
- Spacing Considerations: Leave about 1/8 inch space between spikes or studs to prevent overlap and maintain design clarity.
- Finishing Touches: If the spikes or studs feel loose over time, gently tighten them with the screwdriver.
