STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Choose Hook & Yarn

 Start with the J (6.0 mm) hook for larger stitches or H (5.0 mm) for finer work.

2. Master Basic Stitches

 Practice chain, single crochet (SC), and double crochet (DC) for most projects.






STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

3. Simple Weaving

 Thread yarn through the weaving needle, and weave over-under in alternating rows. Change colors by knotting yarns at the back.





4. Tips for Success

 Experiment with color on small swatches, and hold tools loosely to avoid hand fatigue.



TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Choose the Right Hook: The size of your crochet hook affects the tightness of your stitches. Use the recommended hook size for your yarn to ensure the best results.
- Practice Tension: Keep your yarn tension consistent as you crochet to achieve even stitches. If you're new, practice with different tensions until you find your comfort zone.
- Join Yarn Smoothly: When adding a new skein of yarn, use a knot or splice method to ensure a seamless transition and avoid any visible joins in your work.
- Keep Your Hooks Handy: Use a project bag to store your crochet hooks and weaving needles together with your yarn to prevent losing any tools.
- Explore Different Stitches: Experiment with various crochet stitches beyond the basics. This will add texture and interest to your projects.
